

# ■ English System + Italian Keyboard + Italian Regional Settings

## ■ Detailed Step-by-Step Guide (No Overlap Layout)

### Debian (Linux)

- System Language: Run ``sudo dpkg-reconfigure locales`` → enable `en_US.UTF-8` and `it_IT.UTF-8` → set `LANG=en_US.UTF-8`.
- Regional Formats: Edit ``/etc/default/locale`` → set `LC_*` variables to `it_IT.UTF-8`.
- Keyboard: Run ``sudo dpkg-reconfigure keyboard-configuration`` → choose Italian.

### Windows 10/11

- System Language: Settings → Time & language → Language & region → Display language = English.
- Regional Formats: Settings → Time & language → Regional format = Italian (Italy).
- Keyboard: Add Italian keyboard under Preferred languages → Options.

### Android

- System Language: Settings → System → Languages & input → Languages → put English on top.
- Regional Formats: Set Region = Italy (or keep Italian second in the list).
- Keyboard: Gboard → Settings → Languages → Add Italian layout.

### macOS

- System Language: System Settings → General → Language & Region → Preferred Languages → English first.
- Regional Formats: Region = Italy.
- Keyboard: System Settings → Keyboard → Text Input → Input Sources → Add Italian.

### iOS / iPadOS

- System Language: Settings → General → Language & Region → iPhone/iPad Language = English.
- Regional Formats: Region = Italy.
- Keyboard: Settings → General → Keyboard → Keyboards → Add New Keyboard → Italian.
